

QUICK START GUIDE TO MAKING CRICUT FAUX LEATHER EARRINGS

with a Cricut Maker, Maker 3, Explore 3,
Explore Air 2, or the Cricut Joy

STEP 1

Upload SVG file to Cricut Design Space. For help, visit: amyromeu.com/how-to-upload-svg-files-cricut-design-space

STEP 2

Cut faux leather to a size slightly larger than the shapes that will cut as shown in the Design Space mat preview.

STEP 3

Place faux leather pretty side down on purple strong grip mat (*green mat for Joy*).

STEP 4

Tape faux leather down to mat on all sides with blue painters tape.

STEP 5

Confirm the Standard Fine Point Blade is in the Cricut. In Cricut Design Space, select **Faux Leather (Paper Thin)** as material selection.

For Explore Air 2, turn dial to Custom first. For Joy, Select "On Mat" as cutting method first.

Then **choose "More"** from the Pressure drop down menu.

STEP 6

Load mat and press C button to cut. When cut is complete, check cut with sharp tool before unloading. Repeat cut by pressing C button again if necessary. (*For Joy, follow onscreen prompts to rerun cut.*)

STEP 7

Remove shapes from the mat. Use hole punch or sharp tool to make earring holes.

STEP 8

Use pliers to twist earring hook loop 90 degrees. Use jump rings to attach faux leather earrings to hooks.
